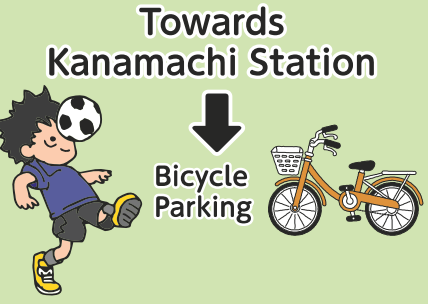
# 2026 Katsushika Ward Children's Festival Venue Guide
